Saturday (Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time)

- 1600 Confessions (*also 25 minutes before every Mass or anytime by asking Father*)
- 1700 Mass
- Introit:* See, I have God for my help. The Lord sustains my soul. I will sacrifice to you with willing heart, and praise your name, O Lord, for it is good.
- Communion:* The Lord, the gracious, the merciful, has made a memorial of his wonders; he gives food to those who fear him.

Sunday (Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time)

- 0800 Mass for Dennis, Enrique[†]
- 1110 Mass for the people of Sacred Heart
(*For antiphons, see Saturday*)

Monday (The Most Holy Trinity)

- 1700 Mass
- Introit:* Bendito sea Dios, Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo, porque ha tenido misericordia con nosotros.
- Communion:* Porque ustedes son hijos de Dios, Dios infundió en sus corazones el Espíritu de su Hijo, que clama: Abbá, Padre.

Tuesday (Saint Lawrence of Brindisi)

- 1200 Mass
- Introit:* The mouth of the just man utters wisdom, and his tongue tells forth what is just; the law of his God is in his heart.
- Communion:* He who ponders the law of the Lord day and night will yield his fruit in due season.

Wednesday (Feast of Saint Mary Magdalene)

- 1300 Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament
- 1620 Vespers & Benediction
- 1700 Mass
- Introit:* The Lord said to Mary Magdalene: Go to my brothers and tell them: I am going to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God.

Communion: The love of Christ impels us, so that those who live may live no longer for themselves, but for him who died for them and was raised.

Thursday (Christ, the Eternal High Priest)

- 1200 Mass
- Introit:* The Lord has sworn an oath he will not change: you are a priest forever, according to the order of Melchizedek.
- Communion:* This is the Body that will be given up for you; this is the Chalice of the new covenant in my Blood, says the Lord; do this, whenever you receive it in memory of me.

Friday (The Mystery of the Holy Cross)

- 1700 Mass
- Introit:* We should glory in the Cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, in whom is our salvation, life and resurrection, through whom we are saved and delivered.
- Communion:* When I am lifted up from the earth, I will draw everyone to myself, says the Lord.

Saturday (Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time)

- 1600 Confessions (*also 25 minutes before every Mass or anytime by asking Father*)
- 1700 Mass
- Introit:* God is in his holy place, God who unites those who dwell in his house; he himself gives might and strength to his people.
- Communion:* Bless the Lord, O my soul, and never forget all his benefits.

Sunday (Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time)

- 0800 Mass
- 1110 Mass for the people of Sacred Heart
(*For antiphons, see Saturday*)

Please note that Adoration begins at 1300 instead of 1200 due to a morning event in the chapel. It will stay this way until the air conditioning is fixed in the CRC.
