Saturday (Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time)

- 1600 Confessions (*also 25 minutes before every Mass or anytime by asking Father*)
- 1700 Mass
- Introit:* O God, come to my assistance;
O Lord, make haste to help me! You are my rescuer, my help; O Lord, do not delay.
Communion: You have given us, O Lord, bread from heaven, endowed with all delights and sweetness in every taste.

Sunday (Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time)

- 0800 Mass
- 1110 Mass for the people of Sacred Heart
(*For antiphons, see Saturday*)

Wednesday (Votive of the Holy Spirit B)

- 1200 Mass
- Introit:* When the Spirit of truth comes, he will teach you all truth, says the Lord. *Communion:* The Spirit, whom I will send you from the Father, will glorify me, says the Lord.
- 1245 Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament (at the Blessed Sacrament Chapel this week)

Thursday (Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord)

- 1200 Mass
- Introit:* In a resplendent cloud the Holy Spirit appeared. The Father's voice was heard: This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased.
Communion: When Christ appears, we shall be like him, for we shall see him as he is.

Friday (The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus)

- 1700 Mass (at the Blessed Sacrament Chapel this week)
- Introit:* The designs of his Heart are from age to age, to rescue their souls from death and to keep them alive in famine. *Communion:* One of the soldiers opened his side with a lance, and at once there came forth blood and water.

Saturday (Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time)

- 1600 Confessions (*also 25 minutes before every Mass or anytime by asking Father*)
- 1700 Mass
- Introit:* Look to your covenant, O Lord, and forget not the life of your poor ones for ever. Arise, O God, and defend your cause, and forget not the cries of those who seek you.
Communion: O Jerusalem, glorify the Lord, who gives you your fill of finest wheat.

Sunday (Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time)

- 0800 Mass
- 1110 Mass for the people of Sacred Heart
(*For antiphons, see Saturday*)

There is no Daily Mass on Monday and Tuesday. Wednesday Adoration and Friday Mass will be in the Blessed Sacrament Chapel.
