❖ **Next Weekend: AMS Collection**

Next weekend our collection will be for the Archdiocese for the Military Services. The Archdiocese for the Military Services includes more than 220 installations in 29 countries, patients in 153 V.A. Medical Centers, federal employees serving outside the boundaries of the USA in 134 countries. Numerically, the AMS is responsible for more than 1.8 million men, women, and children. The AMS carries out its worldwide mission with a very small, full-time staff comprised of 6 bishops, 3 sisters, and 17 lay staff. The major cost elements of the annual \$4 million operating budget are: Pastoral Programs (Vocations, Youth/Young Adult Ministries, Veterans) and clergy worldwide travel, Sacramental Records and Marriage Tribunal, Supporting Services (Administration, Finance, Development, and Communications).

- 1600 Confessions (*also 25 minutes before every Mass or anytime by asking Father*)
- 1700 Mass for Chelsea, Melissa, Joel[†], Francis[†]
Introit: Look to your covenant, O Lord, and forget not the life of your poor ones forever. Arise, O God, and defend your cause, and forget not the cries of those who seek you.
Communion: O Jerusalem, glorify the Lord, who gives you your fill of finest wheat.

Sunday (Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time)

- 0800 Mass for Jonathon, Noah, Aaron, Jimmy[†], Joan[†]
- 1110 Mass for the people of Sacred Heart
(*For antiphons, see Saturday*)

Monday (Saint Lawrence, Deacon and Martyr)

- 1700 Mass en español
Introit: El diácono san Lorenzo se entregó totalmente al servicio de la Iglesia: así mereció sufrir el martirio y reina gloriosamente con Cristo.
Communion: El que quiera servirme que me siga, dice el Señor, y donde yo esté, ahí estará mi servidor.

Tuesday (Saint Clare, Virgin)

- 1200 Mass
Introit: I despised the kingdom of the world and all worldly finery for love of my Lord, Jesus Christ, whom I have seen, whom I have loved, in whom I have believed, in whom has been my delight.
Communion: One thing is necessary: she has chosen the better part, which shall not be taken away from her.

Wednesday (Votive of the Holy Spirit C)

- 1545 Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament
- 1620 Vespers
- 1635 Benediction

- 1700 Mass
Introit: The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, he has sent me to preach the good news to the poor, says the Lord. *Communion:* Send forth your Spirit, and they shall be created, and you shall renew the face of the earth.

1730-1900 Ἀγάπη Family Catechesis

Thursday (The Most Holy Eucharist)

- 1200 Mass
Introit: The Lord opened the gates of heaven, and rained down manna upon them to eat, and gave them bread from heaven: man ate the bread of angels. *Communion:* I am the living bread, that came down from heaven, says the Lord. Whoever eats of this bread will live forever, and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world.

Friday (Assumption Vigil Mass)

- 1700 Mass
Introit: Glorious things are spoken of you, O Mary, who today were exalted above the choirs of Angels into eternal triumph with Christ.
Communion: Blessed is the womb of the Virgin Mary, which bore the Son of the eternal Father.

Saturday (Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time)

- 1600 Confessions (*also 25 minutes before every Mass or anytime by asking Father*)
- 1700 Mass for Julian, Jelai, Julian[†], Matteo[†]
Introit: Turn your eyes, O God, our shield; and look on the face of your anointed one; one day within your courts is better than a thousand elsewhere. *Communion:* I am the living bread that came down from heaven, says the Lord. Whoever eats of this bread will live forever.

Sunday (Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time)

- 0800 Mass for Blas[†], Arnel[†]
- 1110 Mass for the people of Sacred Heart
(*For antiphons, see Saturday*)

Notes: -Wednesday Adoration will only be from 1545 until 1630 due to Mass Camp.
-Thursday Mass will be part of Mass Camp and will not be in Latin.
-Because Assumption is on Saturday, it is not a Holy Day of Obligation.
-Friday evening Mass will be the Assumption, Saturday evening Mass will be Sunday.
