1600 Confessions (*also 25 minutes before every Mass or anytime by asking Father*)

1700 Mass

Introit: As for me, in justice I shall behold your face; I shall be filled with the vision of your glory.

Communion: The sparrow finds a home, and the swallow a nest for her young; by your altars, O Lord of hosts, my King and my God. Blessed are they who dwell in your house, for ever singing your praise.

Sunday (Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time)

0800 Mass

Monday (The Most Holy Trinity)

1700 Mass

Introit: Bendito sea Dios, Pa-dre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo, porque nos ha mostrado un amor inmenso.

Communion: Porque ustedes son hijos de Dios, Dios infundió en sus corazones el Espíritu de su Hijo, que clama: Abbá, Padre.

Tuesday (Memorial of Saint Kateri Tekakwitha, Virgin)

1200 Mass

Introit: Come, bride of Christ, receive the crown, which the Lord has prepared for you for eternity.

Communion: The wise virgin has chosen the better part, and it will not be taken from her.

Wednesday (Memorial of Saint Bonaventure, Bishop and Doctor of the Church)

1200 Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament

1620 Vespers

1635 Benediction

1700 Mass

Introit: Those who are wise will shine brightly like the splendor of the firmament

and those who lead the many to justice shall be like the stars for ever.

Communion: We proclaim Christ crucified; Christ, the power of God and the wisdom of God.

Thursday (The Most Holy Eucharist)

1200 Mass

Introit: The Lord opened the gates of heaven, and rained down manna upon them to eat, and gave them bread from heaven: man ate the bread of angels.

Communion: I am the living bread, that came down from heaven, says the Lord. Whoever eats of this bread will live for ever, and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world.

Friday (The Most Precious Blood of Jesus)

1700 Mass

Introit: You have redeemed us, Lord, by your blood, from every tribe and tongue and people and nation, and have made us into a kingdom for our God.

Communion: The chalice of blessing that we bless is a communion in the Blood of Christ; and the bread that we break is a sharing in the Body of the Lord.

Saturday (Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time)

1600 Confessions (*also 25 minutes before every Mass or anytime by asking Father*)

1700 Mass

Introit: See, I have God for my help.

The Lord sustains my soul. I will sacrifice to you with willing heart, and praise your name, O Lord, for it is good.

Communion: The Lord, the gracious, the merciful, has made a memorial of his wonders; he gives food to those who fear him.

Sunday (Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time)

0800 Mass
